- Sealed goggles or face shield
- Steel-toe boots



TURNAROUND TECHNICIAN

Performs maintenance and inspections in refineries and plants, often in confined spaces or near hazardous chemicals

- Earplugs/earmuffs
- Full-face respirator
- Chemical suit
- Confined space harness
- · Chemical-resistant gloves
- Sealed goggles or visor



TRANSPORT OPERATOR

Handles loading and unloading of flammable or pressurized liquids and gases at terminals, truck bays or rail interfaces

- Hard hat
- Earmuffs
- Dust mask or respirator
- Flame-resistant clothing
- Chemical-resistant gloves
- Goggles
- Metatarsal or chemical-resistant boots



MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

Performs mechanical and electrical maintenance and is exposed to arc flash, slips and chemical hazards

- Hard hat
- Earplugs/earmuffs
- Compact respirator
- Arc-rated clothing
- Electrical gloves
- Safety goggles
- Steel-toe boots



HEALTH, SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL (HSE) SUPERVISOR

Oversees safety and compliance across multiple work zones and ensures appropriate PPE usage

- Hard hat
- Communications headset or earplugs
- Compact respirator
- Flame-resistant clothing
- Protective gloves
- Goggles
- Steel-toe boots
