

# Information on the Regulations in Germany on the Return Options for Packaging, Electrical Equipment and Batteries in the EU

## Packaging

### **Return of Packaging Subject to System Participation as Defined by § 7 of the German Packaging Act (VerpackG)**

Novar GmbH is registered as a manufacturer of packaging filled with goods with the **Stiftung Zentrale Stelle Verpackungsregister** under the number **DE2072203317859** and is thus connected to a return system for free return.

Packaging is a recyclable material and must not be disposed of with normal household waste, but must be collected separately (e.g. public collection points, blue or yellow garbage cans). If necessary, contact your regional or municipal administration/authority regarding collection points and the possibilities of separate collection.

### **Return of packaging that is not subject to system participation as defined in Section 15 (1) of the Packaging Act.**

This packaging cannot be returned to system-participating collection systems (see packaging subject to system participation).

## Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment/WEEE

### **Business-to-Consumer Equipment (B2C)**

Waste electrical and electronic equipment that is potentially used by both private households and users other than private households is considered WEEE from private households.

As a registered manufacturer or distributor of this electrical and electronic equipment (see ElektroG: § 3, (5.)), we have joined together in a collective return system for old equipment. Novar GmbH is registered with the **EAR foundation** as a joint body of manufacturers according to the ElektroG and enforcement authority according to the BattG under the number **DE 94211831**. Suppliers of these electrical appliances are obliged to take back old appliances free of charge. You can return your old equipment to the supplier from whom you purchased it or to a recycling center or public collection point for old electrical equipment. Please contact your regional or municipal administration/authority regarding collection points.

Please also note the following information:

### **Special notes**

The symbol of the crossed-out wheeled garbage can (see also Directive 2012/19/EU) indicates that electrical and electronic products and batteries must not be disposed of with other household waste.

They must be collected and recycled separately in accordance with the legal requirements. Please also observe any nationally applicable labeling obligations.

By disposing of them correctly, you will help to conserve valuable resources and avoid possible negative effects on human health and the environment.

Used batteries, accumulators and lamps that can be removed from the old device without destroying it must be separated from the old device before being handed over to a collection point and fed into the disposal channels provided for this purpose.

You must delete personal data on the old devices to be disposed of on your own responsibility.

### **Business-to-Business Devices (B2B)**

For our B2B devices (see ElektroG: §19), which cannot be handed in at a collective take-back system, we offer you - unless otherwise contractually agreed - the following options for return:

### **Device Batteries**

As a registered manufacturer or distributor of this electrical and electronic equipment (see ElektroG: § 3, (5.)), we have joined together in a collective return system for old equipment. Novar GmbH is registered with the **EAR foundation** as a joint body of manufacturers according to the ElektroG and enforcement authority according to the BattG under the number **DE 94211831**. Suppliers of these batteries are obliged to take back the portable batteries free of charge. You can return your used battery to the supplier from whom you purchased it or to a recycling center or public collection point for portable batteries. Please contact your regional or municipal administration/authority regarding collection points.
